Format and Rules:

Round 1 (Elimination Round, Time bound): One member from each team will start and finish the race amidst the hindrances in their way. They will be however blind folded & will have to very closely listen and follow all the instructions given only by their team members, eliminating the spy's voice and try to move ahead in the race. Spy will try and sabotage their way by giving wrong instructions here.

Added Advantage: The one team who completes the round 1 & 2 at the earliest will have an advantage of using the doctor's life line and can move on to the next round despite being eliminated.

Round 2 (Elimination Round, Time bound): One member from the team will be blind folded again and will have to cross the lazer maze without getting touched within the box. The members will have to very closely listen and follow all the instructions given only by their team members, eliminating the spy's voice and try to move ahead in the race. Spy will try and sabotage their way by giving wrong instructions here.

Round 3 (Time bound): This is the treasure hunt round and each remaining team has to find their clues from different places, decode the riddle/clue given to reach the treasure in order to win. Team with the least time taken will be the winner.

Format and Rules:

Round 1: Bollywood Trivia Time

Description: A quiz round focusing on famous Bollywood movies, songs, and dialogues from the 90s and early 2000s. The questions will cover various topics such as hit movie dialogues, memorable film plots, song lyrics, and actors' iconic roles.

Example Questions:

Gameplay:

1. Quiz Mechanics:
 - Each team will be presented with a series of riddles or questions related to iconic items and props from the 90s and 00s.
 - Example Question: Play the theme music from "Dilwale Dulhania Le Jayenge" and ask the teams to identify the correct item:
 - a) Crow
 - b) mandolin
 - c) Airplane
 - d) Violin
 - Teams must buzz in to answer, and the first team to respond correctly will earn that item.
2. Item Accumulation:
 - Each correct answer will add the corresponding item to the team's list.
 - A variety of items will be included to cover different aspects of 90s and 00s culture (e.g., toys, gadgets, movies).
3. Advancement:
 - The 5 teams with the highest number of items collected at the end of the quiz will advance to the next round.

Round 2: Creative Storytelling | **No. Of teams:** 5 Teams | **Format:** Story Creation

Objective: Teams must craft a short story incorporating all the items they won in Round 1.

Gameplay:

Rounds:

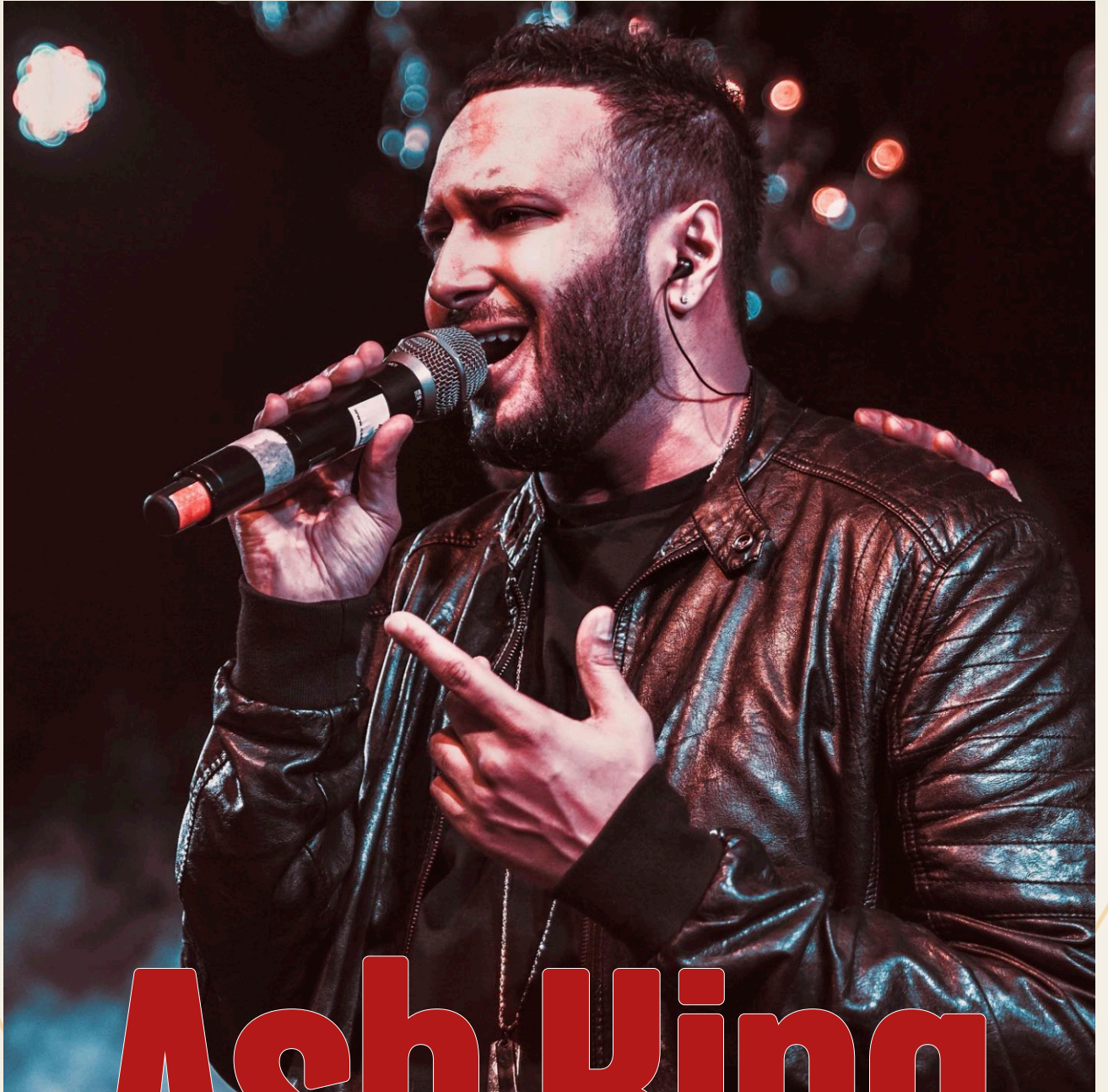
