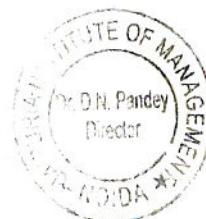

## Global Initiative by Jaipuria Institute of Management: Prof. Ashish Chandra from University of Houston, Clearlake, USA invited to teach at Jaipuria campuses

International Relations Committee of the institute is engaged in assisting the students to extend their networks globally. In the past, the committee has continuously organized various visits and events very successfully.

Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida witnessed the visit of Dr. Ashish Chandra, Professor at University of Houston, Clearlake from 6<sup>th</sup> Nov'17 till 9<sup>th</sup> Nov'17. He has been visiting all the four campuses of Jaipuria along with it he was also working on his project. He visited Indore, Lucknow and Jaipur campuses between 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct – 1<sup>st</sup> Nov and have deliberated on topics like 'Demand Forecasting and market size identification', 'Developing Product strategy, Brand Value Chain, Formulating Distribution Strategy', 'Changing trends in family buying behavior, Interaction of Culture and consumer behaviour' etc. He wanted to interact with the Indian students and thus he took guest lectures at Jaipuria Institute of Management. He talked about topics related to consumer behavior and research methodology.

On his arrival to Noida Campus, he was warmly welcomed by **Dr. Kavita Pathak, Director, Noida along with Dr. Poonam Sharma, Chairperson, International Relations**. A brief talk followed thereafter before he could resume his sessions with the students.

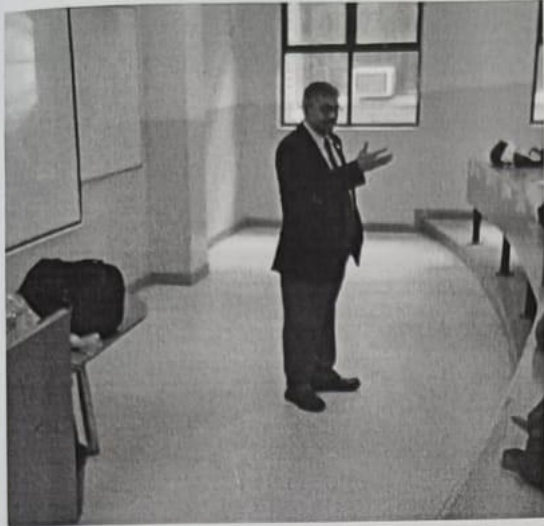




In his class sessions, Dr. Chandra, being a healthcare specialist elaborated about the services offered in this sector. In addition to this he threw light on some marketing techniques like identification of market identify of a service, which market segment you have to focus more.

He deliberated about the cultural diversity and exemplified the same through Coca Cola advertisements in which they use different techniques of advertisements like in Diwali the advertisements are focused on lightning, on Christmas the advertisement is focused on Santa clause and Christmas tree and many more.

Turkey revolution was also a part of his talk where he explained how Turkey was a secular country but now Turkey has become radicalized. He believes that religion should not be a governing factor in an organization. He enacted a short play, for students to learn and understand the different culture.



Further he also gave some interview tips like how to push the interviewer to what you know, distract the interviewer, leadership, who is coming to interview, learned about interviewer everything (family structure, religion, articles) about company, structure of interview.

During his lecture he was trying to interact with each and every student in different ways. He also explained to the young minds that helmets are lifestyle choices and not just decorative pieces, but still some of us don't place our helmets on head or most of times we don't use it.

His sessions at Jaipuria were a combination of knowledge and humour. Students really had a great time attending his session. This was a great opportunity for the students, interacting with such experienced international faculty.



He took a session on '**Marketing Plan**' as well where he asked the students about the company assigned by the college for marketing management field visit. Further, he shared his knowledge by telling each group about how they can recognize product decision and pricing strategy for the products and services offered by the company.

- 3) **Mutual Student Exchange Program and Internship Opportunities**

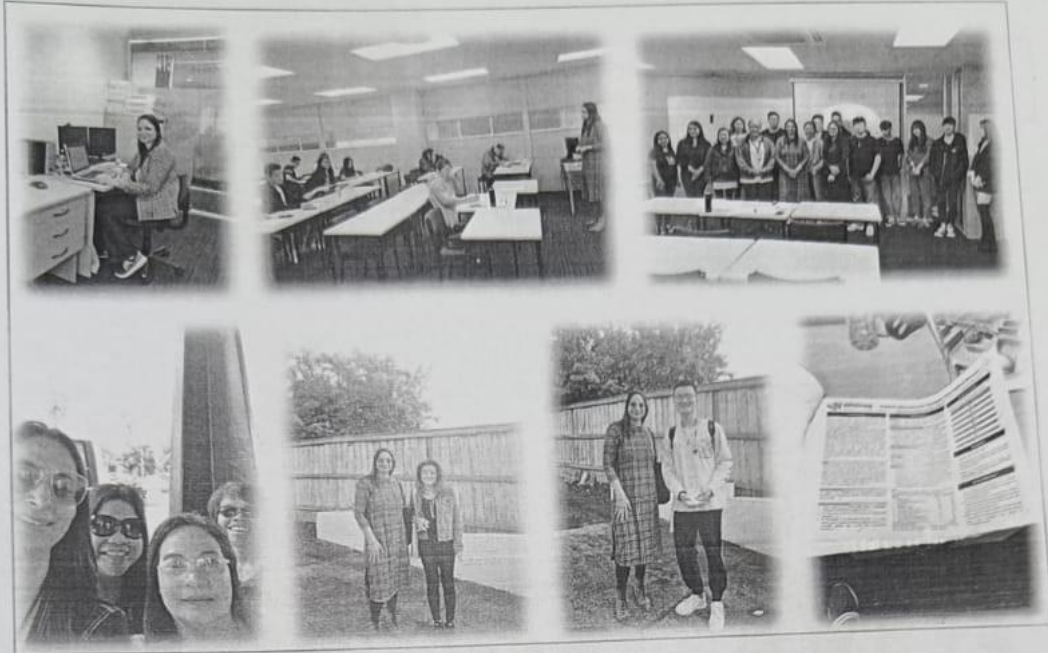
She is also undertaking pedagogical and educational activities at WelTec and Whitireia, New Zealand for a period two months. Her visit has already started showing results from the day-1.

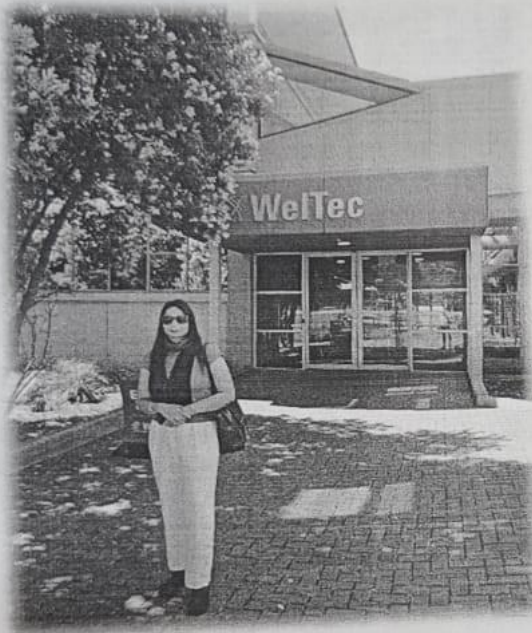

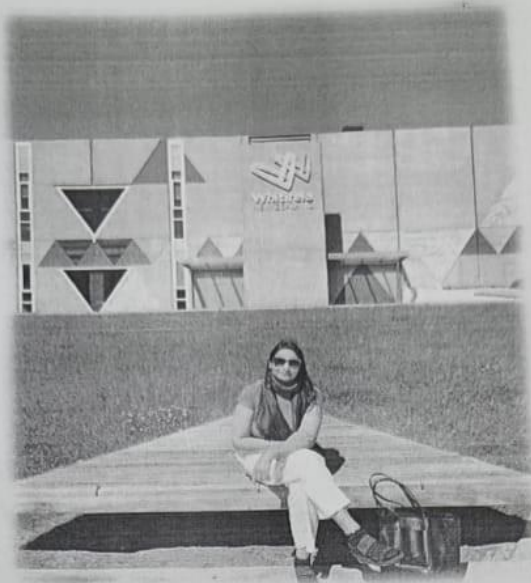
*Prof. Poonam Sharma's visit to Wellington campuses of

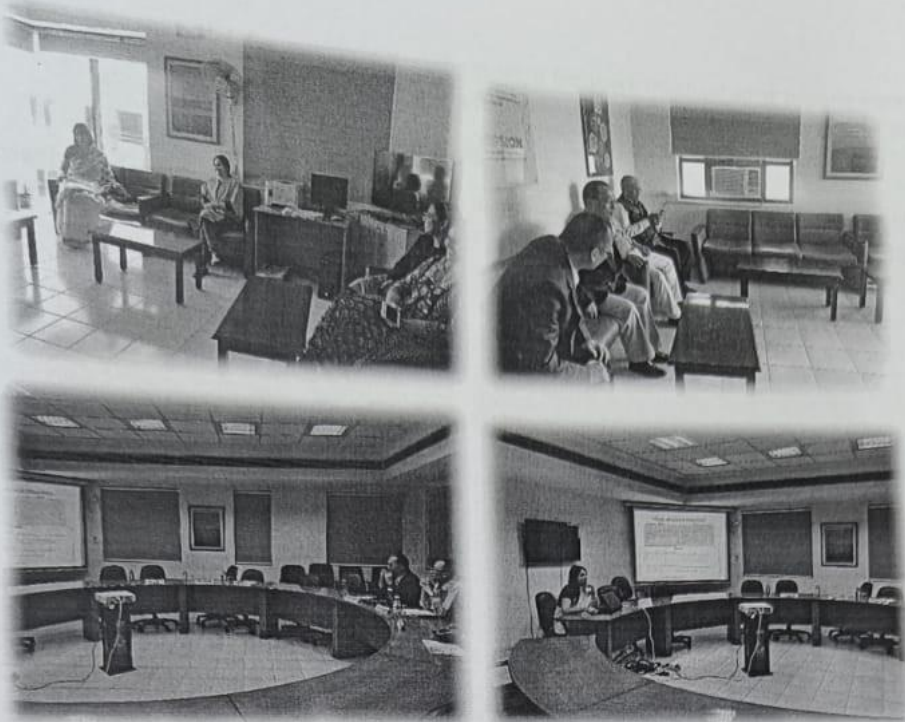


Session by Director, Dr. D.N Pandey on the topic" Leadership issue in higher education"

The purpose of this program is to nominate faculty members from Jaipuria Institute of Management who will collaborate in teaching of a course at Royal Institute of Management, Bhutan. Two professors from each campus will be expected to travel to the partner institution for 10 to 15 days. In those days the faculty will teach a class, meet with other faculty members in order to discuss future potential projects, give an open lecture to the community, research projects, etc. Home institution are expected to cover the cost of the airfare of their own faculty. Accommodations and meals for visiting professors, will be covered by the host institute and vice versa.

**Expected Results:** Student's exposure to international faculty members, promote international curriculum, promote joint teaching programs, integrate activities with students from universities in different countries, open doors to possibilities for future collaborations

**How it works:**

- Home institutes will be responsible for reaching out to different faculties within their own institution to identify faculty members interested in participating
- Host institute will identify similar project proposals and will then notify the respective institutions
- The group of collaborating faculty members will design the syllabus and activities to be implemented during the visits
- A preliminary plan will be shared by the host institute
- Selected faculty members will participate in the short-term faculty exchange program

**What is expected from participants?**

Selected participants are expected to complete the following tasks as part of their participation in this program:

**Before Visit:**

- A potential match is introduced to faculty member. Both participants are expected to establish communication to have an initial conversation.
- After match is confirmed, faculty members are expected to establish communication to brainstorm and agree on the different activities planned for the visit. A planning activity document should be sent to both the institutes prior to the semester start.
- Participants/ Program Coordinator will coordinate with host institution about housing and meals during the visit

**During Visit:**

- Visiting faculty will teach or co-teach his/her colleague's classes
- Visiting faculty will offer a lecture on his/her expertise open to the community
- Visiting faculty will meet with various academic departments to discuss potential future projects
- Faculties are highly encouraged to participate in a community outreach activity

- An online/virtual activity will be organized by the professors to give students from both institutions the opportunity to interact. This activity could take place anytime during the visit

**After Visit:**

- Faculty is expected to share the evaluation survey
  - Each faculty will complete a final report by the end of the visit. This report will be shared and approved by the host institute and home institute
  - Each participating faculty will be awarded a certificate of completion under the Faculty Exchange Program




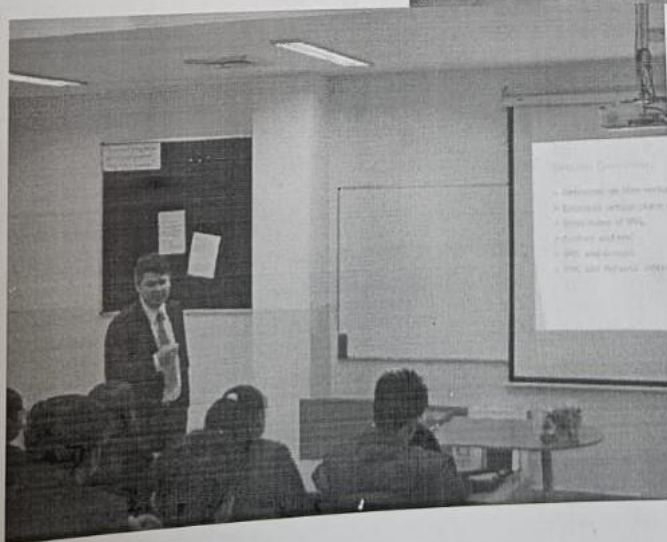


### Guest Talk by John O'Sullivan on Non-Verbal Communication

December 15, 2017 marked a very special place in the books of Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida as the day was embraced by **Dr. Kuldeep Kumar, Professor, Department of Economics and Statistics at Bond Business School, Bond University, Queensland, Australia** to give his valuable insight on the topic "**Financial Statement Frauds: Detection and possibility of Company failure.**"



The field of business failure prediction has many aliases, such as bankruptcy prediction, firm failure prediction and financial distress prediction. Hereafter it will be referred to as **Business Failure Prediction (BFP)**. As the name suggests, BFP involves developing models that attempt to predict the financial failure of a business before it actually happens.

Some benefits from accurate business failure predictions are:

- Banks, investment banks, credit unions, and other financial institutions could avoid lending to businesses that will fail, and thus never repay their loans.
- The financial investment sector could improve the risk return trade-off from investments by not investing in failing businesses.
- Businesses could establish long-term relationships with other businesses (such as suppliers) that will not fail in the future, and thus increase the longevity and viability of their business relationships.
- Regulatory bodies could make early identifications of failing businesses. This early identification assists regulatory bodies in ensuring that business failure is 'handled' legally and illegal activities, such as avoiding taxes or diluting debt holders' claims by issuing substantial common stock dividends prior to failure, are avoided.





The session was highly attended and cherished by everyone present in the vicinity. All in all, the journey was an exciting, exhilarating and a learning experience in a package of one session. In this ever changing and ever evolving time there occurs a need to understand the processes and techniques involved in the financial transactions in order to make sure that there exists a smooth flow of cash and that any kind of discrepancy can be avoided. Living in a time where even a slight flaw in the modes and methods of recording transactions can be devastating, a lecture of such headline proved to be really crucial for understanding a wide range of nitty gritty regarding the ways of carrying out financial transactions.





Further some valuable insights were given upon **Transparency International** which is a leading non-political, independent, non-governmental anti-corruption organization of India. The insights highlighted the voice TII provides to the victims and witnesses of corruption.

Students from the Noida and Jaipur Campus arrived at the Lucknow Campus and completed the formalities such as Currency Exchange.

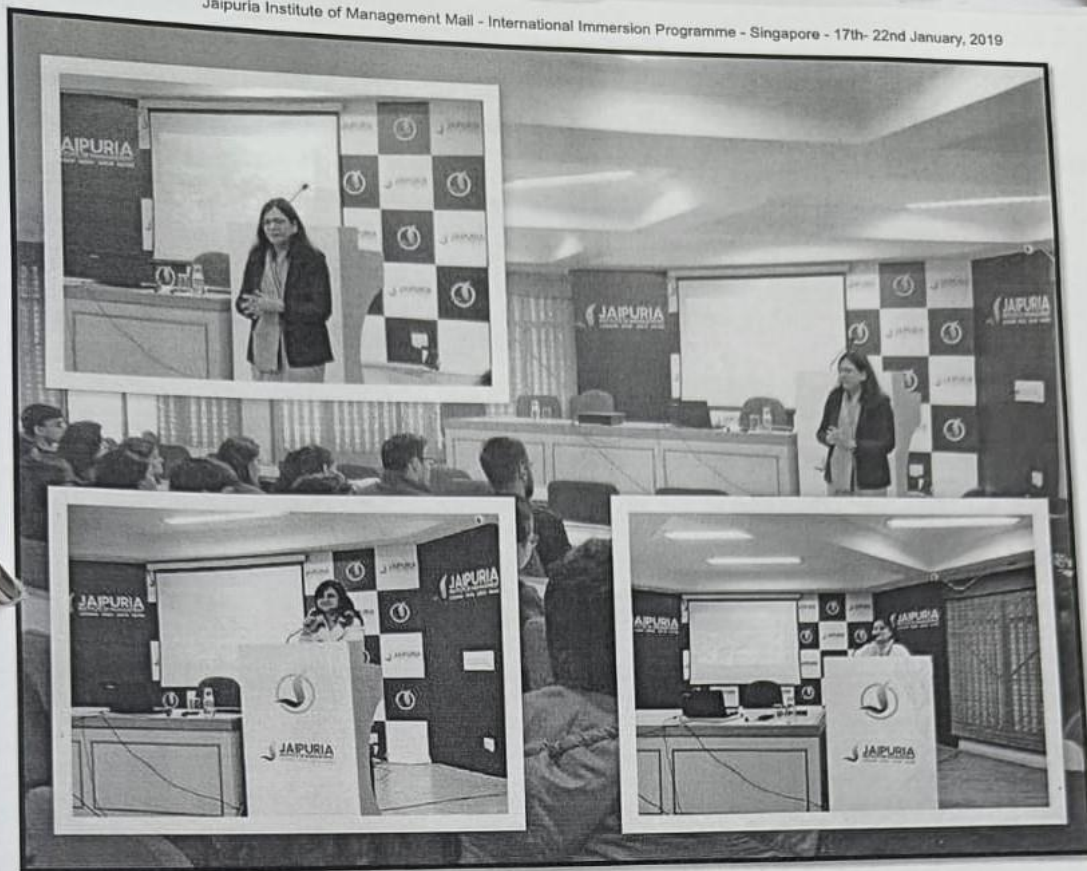


#### 12:30 P.M. (IST): Briefing Session

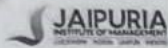

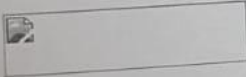

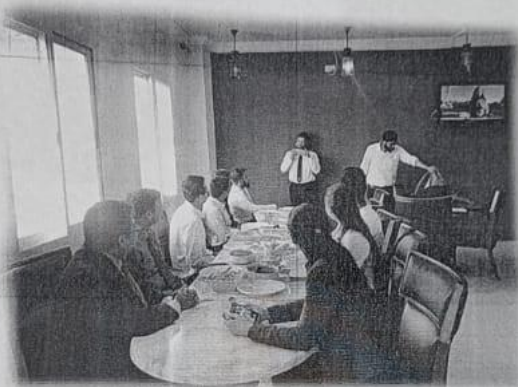


Day 0: 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2018

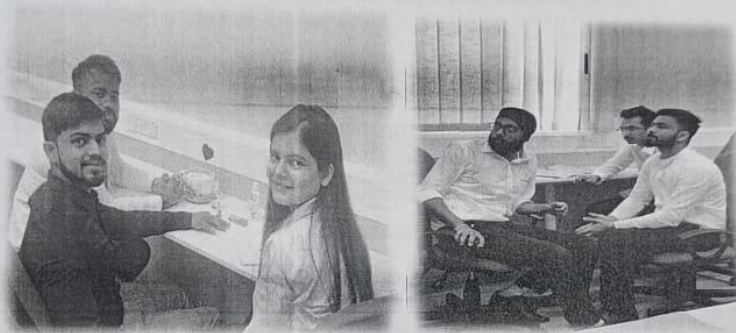
Dubai Parks and Resorts

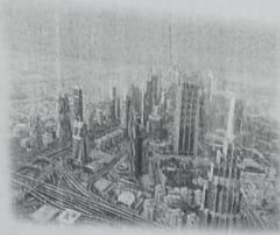
**Guest Talk Session on "Concept of Entrepreneurship" by Dr. Kakul Agha**
