Rules for Video

- · Prerecorded video should be submitted through the submission link.
- · The first frame should contain scholars Name, Affiliation and Topic.

Rules for PowerPoint Presentation

Before you start work on your slide, you should take the following rules into account:

- · First slide should contain scholars Name, Affiliation and Topic.
- · Your slide is to be presented from the beginning of your oration.
- · No additional electronic media (e.g. sound and video files) are permitted.
