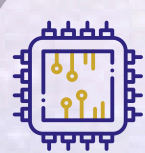
E-SUMMIT 2026

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Speaker Norms – Travel & Accommodation

To ensure seamless coordination and professional conduct, the following norms shall apply:

1. Travel Policy

- The college will bear travel expenses only for the invited speaker. Expenses of accompanying team members or staff will not be covered.
- Travel tickets will be fully arranged and managed by the college.
- Confirmed travel tickets will be shared with the speaker 4–5 days prior to the event.
- Local transportation (pickup and drop from airport/railway station to hotel/venue) will be arranged by the organizing committee.
- Any changes in travel plans must be immediately communicated to the event coordinator.

2. Accommodation Policy

- Accommodation (if required) will be arranged by the organizing committee for the invited speaker only.
- Check-in and check-out timelines will align with the event schedule.

3. Session & Conduct Guidelines

- Speakers must strictly adhere to the allotted time slot.
- Presentation materials (if any) must be shared 48 hours prior to the session.
- Content must remain professional, respectful, and aligned with academic and institutional values.
- Direct selling, aggressive promotions, political content, or controversial remarks are not permitted.
- Brand references may be included only for educational or experiential learning purposes.
- Recording and media rights of the session will remain with the institute unless otherwise agreed in writing.
